The HKSAR government "is committed to Hong Kong's continuing rise as a center for international legal and disputeresolution services," she said on Wednesday.

Lam was addressing the International Dispute Resolution Conference, which drew some 500 professionals from various sectors worldwide to Hong Kong to discuss and exchange ideas on the settlement of disputes.

She cited the almost US\$20-million fund the SAR government has allocated to support the development and initial operation of an electronic Business Related Arbitration and Mediation system (eBRAM).

The system is a secure and cost-effective deal-making and disputeresolution online service for cross-border commercial and trade disputes, including those relating to projects under the Belt and Road Initiative, she said, and is expected to be in operation by the end of this year.
