#### Contents

In this seminar, Professor TK Iu will introduce participants to how "evaluative mediation" came about, its features and its differences with "facilitative mediation". Professor Iu will make use of certain parts of Professor L. Riskin's learned article and the role play of "Broken Glass Door" to illustrate the unique features of "evaluative mediation". Upon completion of the seminar, participants should be more knowledgeable on the different styles of mediation and they should be more comfortable to display different mediation skills and styles to suit different factual and emotional dimensions of each dispute that he/she may have to mediate in the future. This seminar is open to all mediators but is particularly useful for mediation coaches who need to distinguish the differences between incorrect skills and different mediation styles.

## **Professor IU Ting Kwok**

Iu Ting Kwok (also known as TK) is a HKMAAL accredited mediator (general and family) as well as an accredited family mediation supervisor.

TK is active in mediation training. He is a lead trainer in HKMAAL accredited general mediation courses. He is also a HKMAAL assessor. TK speaks at various mediation seminars and workshops both in Hong Kong and overseas.

Academically, TK is an adjunct professor at HKSYU; he is also an adjunct assistant professor in the Department of Law at HKU, and the JC School of Public Health and Primary Care, Faculty of Medicine at CUHK.

He has written articles for journals including *Hong Kong Lawyer*, *Asian Dispute Review* and *Asian Journal on Mediation*.

Since November 2012, TK has been a member of the regulatory framework subcommittee of the Department of Justice. He also sits on the mediation accreditation committee of HKMAAL.

Internationally, TK sits as a panel mediator at the Singapore International Mediation Centre and the World Trade Center Macau Arbitration Center.
